Trust Within the Workplace: Existing Research and New Directions

Prof. Kurt T. Dirks (PhD)

Monday, 10th July 2023, at Goethe University Frankfurt, Campus Westend, Lecture Hall (Hörsaal) HZ 11, 18.30h – 20.00h, followed by a reception

The concept of trust has emerged as a core concept in research in organizational behavior, with important implications for groups and organizations. Professor Dirks will summarize the key questions and insights from a quarter-century of research. While considering directions for future research, he will discuss several new studies.

Kurt Dirks is best known for his research on the determinants, barriers, and outcomes of trust within organizations and he has published several highly cited and award-winning articles on the topic. The research has been covered by the popular press such as Business Week, Fortune, New York Times, and the Washington Post. Prior to his current roles, Kurt has served in several leadership positions at the Olin Business School,



including Interim Dean, and at the university, including Vice Chancellor of International Affairs.
